March 19, 2011
Minnich's Hit Picnic Area

Balance of \$115 after deposit and bills are paid.

Minutes of previous meeting were discussed and approved.

Old Business:

- The grant application discussed at last month's meeting was not gotten in as PPF didn't get the paperwork out in time for the application deadline. It was proposed that the money from this grant was to be used for a deck on the Handicapped trail at Minnich's Hit picnic area. We will reapply for this grant at a later date.
- The state forest approved the area to place a high tie at the Minnich's Hit picnic area. This area is to be 20'X 30' and will accommodate 3 horses. It will be constructed with a base of stone, fabric and mulch.
- The construction of a manure pit at the location of the snowmobile parking lot/horse campsites was discussed. It will need to have a roof and will be constructed with railroad ties provided by the State Forestry. We will need to provide concrete for the floor of the pit.
- The membership drive/fund raiser at the Elizabethville Tractor Supply discussed at our last meeting is scheduled for April 23rd. We will sell soup, hot dogs and baked goods.

New Business:

- We hauled rock in for the sides of the handicapped trail during our work day on March 19th, 2011. We scheduled another work day for April 9th 2011 at 10 a.m. Our plan for this work day is to begin to place the rock we gathered along the trail. We will also begin to level and build up the trail. We will have a covered dish meal at the completion of our work day.
