

ORDINANCE NO. 277

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE
NO. 236, RELATING TO SNOW EMERGENCIES

Be it ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the
Village of Grandview, Illinois, that:

Section 1. All streets within the Village of Grandview shall be
"snow emergency" routes.

Section 2. A "snow emergency" shall exist in the Village of
Grandview whenever 2 inches of snow or more falls, and for 12
hours after the conclusion of each such snowfall.

Section 3. During a "snow emergency," it shall be unlawful for
any person to park or leave a motor vehicle of any type in the
traveled portion of any snow emergency route, or alongside or
adjacent to any such route, or in a private driveway in a
position that interferes with the plowing or removal of snow.

Section 4. Any vehicle parked in violation of this ordinance may
be towed or removed.

Section 5. Any person who violates this ordinance may be
punished by a fine of not more than \$200.00 per occurrence.

Section 6. Signs indicating that there shall be no parking
during snow emergencies may be erected, by order of the trustee
who chairs the standing committee on streets. The placement and
number of such signs, if any, shall be left to the discretion of
such trustee.

Section 7. Any portion of Ordinance No. 236 or any other
ordinance which conflicts with this ordinance is hereby repealed.

Section 8. Because the plowing and removal of snow from Village
streets has an important effect on public health and safety, this
ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form, and it shall

become effective immediately upon its passage and publication.
