Fort Garry Community Centre Fair Play Policy

The Fort Garry Community Centre believes that every player is entitled to a fair and equitable amount of playing time over the course of the regular season, and the opportunity to develop skills at various positions.

The Fort Garry Community Centre believes that all players deserve an equal opportunity to learn, develop and participate at all levels. Under this policy, all players who attend **all** planned practices and games, work hard, display good sportsmanship, and conduct themselves according to the Fort Garry Community Centre Player Code of Conduct and Responsibilities (referred to herein as the Player Code of Conduct), are guaranteed fair treatment over the course of the season.

Fair and Equitable playing time means that all players will be required to sit approximately the same amount of time.

Coaches are permitted under this policy to sit a player for part of a game and to enforce discipline in the event that an athlete does not meet the obligations set forth in the Player Code of Conduct.

Coaches are required to hold a team meeting with parents and players at the beginning of the season to discuss this policy and the Player Code of Conduct, and to describe the discipline rules that will apply over the course of the season. In the event of a disagreement over these rules, the Fort Garry Community Centre Convener for the age division and the Fort Garry Community Centre Board of Directors, shall work to resolve the dispute.
