It has been 30 years since osprey have nesting on Lake Marburg! They have, once again, built on a nesting platform at “Long Island”.

Osprey are a PA Threatened species and in need of protection. Temporary buoys along with signage have been placed around the nest site to prevent disturbance while the pair are nesting, incubating eggs, and rearing chicks.

Until the end of the nesting season state park management, the PA Game Commission, and the PA Fish & Boat Commission will be monitoring the nest site for disturbances. Approach inside the buoys is considered disturbing the nest and is subject to fines up to \$1000.00.

PLEASE share the resources of Lake Marburg with our native wildlife and pardon the temporary protected area around the nesting site. Enjoy your boating and fishing opportunities on Lake Marburg at Codorus State Park. Take the opportunity to view this marvel of nature from a safe distance.
