

OUR HISTORY

The Friends of Codorus State Park began in early 2006 at the request of the Park Manager, Warren Werntz. Warren wanted a "few extra pairs of hands-about 50 to donate time and sweat to help keep up the Park, and also to raise funds for the Park. A group of about 100 people formed in January. Membership fees were \$5.00 for annual dues, to cover the cost of mailings to members.

Since that humble beginning, we have grown to over 300 members, including local businesses and organizations. We have opened a Gift Shop, Outpost Camp Store, held seasonal events like Summer Blast, Halloween in the Park, Breakfast with Santa, and Easter Egg hunt, and held member events like the Thanksgiving dinner and Spring Fling Banquet. We also have a very dedicated group of wood splitters who split and stack wood for sale in the campground. All of this combined has helped to accomplish some much needed Park items and repairs. But we want to do more.
